Online Admission in Deshbandhu College for Girls in CBCS under University of Calcutta for the Session 2020-21

The first Merit list will be published at the College website on **27/08/2020** after **4 P.M.** The list for B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Hons./General will remain active for 48 hours, following which the **Waiting List** would be activated. The status of vacancy in different subjects will be notified in the website on a regular basis after the actual admission starts. *Keep an eye on this page for any update on the status of the Waiting List.*

The Selection will be strictly on the basis of merit of the candidates who have applied and on the availability of the seats in the college for different courses.

General Rules:

Candidates who have passed 10+2 Examination from All India Board or Councils (i.e. WBCHSE/WBBME/ CBSE / ISC/NIOS/Rabindra Mukta Vidyalaya are eligible to apply for Hons. and General Courses in B.A./B.Sc/ B.Com and BBA Hons. (self financed) provided they fulfill all the criteria under University of Calcutta to study the courses.

As per CU rule, no candidate shall be allowed to take admission after a lapse of more than 5 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying Examination. The year of admission shall not be taken into account while calculating the year of passing the previous qualifying Examination.

Reservation Policy for Admission shall be guided by the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions Act (Resevation in Admission) 2013 and by the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions Act (Reservation in Admission) 2014.

For admission in Hons. Courses in any of the streams mentioned above, a candidate belonging to General Category must secure a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate and 45% marks in the subject of Hons. A candidate belonging to SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B must have an aggregate of 40% and 40% marks in the subject of Hons.

For admission in General Courses in any of the streams mentioned above, a candidate must in minimum have passed 10+2 Examination.

Payment of Admission Fee

The Candidates whose names come up in the first Merit list can download the Challan and take admission by paying admission fees through **State Bank-Collect** (SB-Collect) online and/or offline at any **SBI Branch**. The link will stay active for 48 hours, following which the Waiting List would be activated.

The documents of the candidates submitted with the form will be checked and verified after the students report to college when the classes begin. All applicants must keep two hardcopies of the filled in form with them which has to be produced at the college office later.

As per the Government Notification, (No.804-Edn CS/10m-95/14, dated the admission will be summarily cancelled if the documents are not in conformity with the declaration of the form submitted online by the candidate.
